Collecting data on alumni career paths: The survey results can be used to track alumni career paths and measure the university's impact on their professional and personal lives.




Identifying alumni needs and expectations: Alumni feedback can be used to improve the programs and services offered by the university.



>>> Overall, young entrepreneurs have successfully leveraged the skills acquired during their training at UPES to manage their projects.






Academic >Training at UPES
